Limited Roster Changes

As we examine student growth data, we want to ensure that students are provided with every opportunity to receive appropriate educational services that are tailored to their individual needs. Because of this, we will be making some roster changes in High Strides classes for second semester, based upon a combination of classroom achievement and growth data from fall to winter interim performance, and may include some possible changes to the overall structure of our schedule. This will allow teachers a better opportunity to provide more targeted instruction and will have a positive impact on student achievement, engagement, and classroom environment prior to the winter interim. This will NOT impact HGT classes, exploratory classes, intervention classes, or enrichments. Thank you for your understanding and support.
