The topic will be on The Denver Plan 2020 and the new Vision of the Graduate and Classroom. This is a special forum, open to ALL DPS parents.

Morey wants to introduce a new support role we have to offer our students.

My name is Averill Hovey and I am a licensed professional counselor and art therapist. I have worked in schools for 15 years as a teacher, a coach, counselor and now a member of school support staff. I am here to help students achieve through supporting them through and providing them the tools to experience the social emotional challenges they might face. This includes helping them identify and cultivate protective factors that aid them in making healthy choices for themselves when they experience stress or hardship.

I am the Prevention Specialist, a new position within Denver Public Schools through the Office of Social Emotional Learning. I want to let you know about the programs I will be running this year at Morey, and also offer you some insight as to how I am going to be supporting students and school throughout this year. I am including my contact information so you might be able to connect with me with questions, concerns or feedback.

What is a Prevention Specialist?

My position has been created to support schools in the design, implementation and evaluation of Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) for substance use prevention and early intervention in DPS schools (grades 6-8). Services will range from prevention initiatives that impact entire school populations to targeted interventions with identified students who are in or are at risk of entering into the early stages of substance use. I will also offer alternatives to traditional disciplinary measures to substance related offenses.

What I offer Morey Middle School.

I offer the **Brief Risk Reduction Interview and Intervention Model (BRRIM)** to students and families. This supports family development and assesses substance use risk while targeting necessary supports and teasing out appropriate referrals as needed.

I will be running **The Sources of Strength Project** which is a program that supports the development of healthy and trusting community through empowering youth through leadership, and establishing norms surrounding relationship development and systems of support.

The Strengthening Families Program (SFP) is a nationally and internationally recognized parenting and family strengthening program **for high-risk and general population families**. SFP is an evidence-based family skills training program found to significantly improve parenting skills and family relationships, reduce problem behaviors, delinquency and alcohol and drug abuse in children and to improve social competencies and school performance.

Social Action Youth Council is a program designed by Denver RAP (Resource for Awareness and Prevention) specifically for youth and teens as a starting point for their own social action campaign/ council. Everyone has the power to create change in their community. It might be a small change, like adding recycling bins to your community park; or it could be large, like changing your peers' attitudes about teenage drinking. No matter the size, every positive change is important, and is well worth the effort it takes to accomplish it. Each of these changes starts the same way: when someone who cares takes action.
