School Support Groups:

This semester we are hoping to start some additional student support groups at Morey.

The Grief and Loss Group. We are partnering with Judi's House (a local organization who specializes in child/teen death loss support) to offer a support group to those students who have had a death loss in their immediate, extended or chosen family (friends/ loved ones close to student). We understand the impact that loss can have of a child in all areas of their life. This is an opportunity for students to honor the person that they have lost, while also developing healthy coping skills for times when difficult conversations or emotions emerge surrounding the loss.

The Incarcerated Family Member Group. We are hoping to begin a support group for those in the Morey Community who have lost family members through incarceration. This kind of loss is often not addressed, and is therefore often overlooked and becomes disenfranchised. We understand the impact that this experience can have on our students. This group will be an opportunity for students to come together, form community around their experience, share about the person that they are missing/ have lost, and develop healthy coping skills for when difficult conversations or emotions arise surrounding their loss.
